### SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

Person who designs, implements, updates, analyses and assesses activities and provides guidance and counselling services in one or more social programs.

### SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS

- Offers support to community frontline workers and families of children/youth who are at risk or who have been diagnosed with language, communication, behavioral and developmental disorders such as Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- Provide clinical skills instruction and behavior reduction protocols and best practices to those with working with clients.
- Assist with parent and caregiver training in line with client's individualized treatment and behavior reduction protocols and to promote skill acquisition in the following areas: communication, social, daily living, independence, personal hygiene, and fine and gross motor.

### REQUIREMENTS

#### Education:

- Must have the required university degree in social work;
- If using the reserved title, the person must provide her/his employer with annual proof that she/he is a member of the Ordre professionnel des travailleurs sociaux du Québec.

#### Experience:

- Two (2) years of pertinent experience.

- Knowledge of appropriate ways to handle intervention with challenging behavior;
- Good understanding of psychosocial issues;

- Ability in the identification and analysis of the clientele needs;
- Ability to communicate theoretical and practical knowledge, as applied to coaching and training;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills;
- Autonomous, discrete and empathetic;
- Team work capabilities.
