SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

Person who assumes responsibility for a range of nursing care activities based on the bio-psycho-social needs of assigned users or groups of people. She/he assesses users' state of health, determines and ensures the implementation of nursing care and treatment plans for users with complex health problems and/or various bio-psycho-social dimensions. She/he provides nursing and medical care and treatment to maintain health, restore health and prevent disease. She/he can prescribe laboratory analyzes, treatments, products, medication and dressings in the fields of wound care, public health and routine care according to the regulations in force.

She/he designs, applies and evaluates care programs requiring advanced knowledge, aimed at complex health problems and/or involving various bio-psycho-social dimensions. She/he participates in the development or adaptation of clinical and quality-of-care assessment tools, coordinates teamwork and plays an advisory role with colleagues and the interdisciplinary team.

She/he identifies, for the users, the needs and interventions requiring a coordination of services within the institution and between different institutions or organizations in the community. She/he coordinates these services, as needed.

She/he provides orientation for new staff and assists with the training of interns. She/he supervises the teaching of users, their relatives and groups of people in specific programs and collaborates on research.

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing or an undergraduate degree consisting of three (3) admissible certificates, of which two (2) are accredited certificates in Nursing;
- Holder of the training Nonviolent Crisis Intervention or OMEGA or willingness to follow it.
