

PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS RESPECTING THE ELECTION FOR CBHSSJB CHAIRPERSON 2024

RUN-OFF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the Returning Officer has called a run-off election for the office of the Chairperson of the Cree Board of Health and Social Services of James Bay (**CBHSSJB**) for this 2024 election, to be held between the following two (2) candidates:

Jeannie Pelletier Bertie Wapachee

This run-off election is called pursuant to Article 17 of CBHSSJB "Consolidated By law No 9: By-law respecting the Procedure for the Election of the Cree Representative of the Members of the Cree Nation Government and Chairperson of the Cree Board of Health and Social Services of James Bay" (Election By law).

Qualifications to Vote

The qualifications to vote in the election of the CBHSSJB Chairperson are as follows:

- To be a member of the Cree Nation Government (enrolled or entitled to be enrolled as a Cree beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Quebec Agreement);
- To be of the age of majority on the date of the original main election poll (18 years of age on November 12, 2024); and
- Not to be affected by any legal incapacity.

In accordance with section 17.03 of the Election By-law, the electoral list for this run-off poll shall be the same as for the first election poll.
