



Appointment of Interim Executive Director

The Board voted to approve Christina Biron as interim Executive Director, beginning on September 20, 2025, until such time as a new Executive Director has been appointed.

The contract for the current ED, Daniel St-Amour, ends on September 19, and the search for a new ED will not be completed by that time. Between now and the end of his contract, Mr. St-Amour will mentor Ms. Biron to ensure a transfer of skills, knowledge and experience, and will consult with and involve her in his day-to-day functions and decision-making processes.



Governance Advisory Committee: Amendment to Council of Midwives Bylaw

The Board approved amendments to the Council of Midwives (CMW) bylaw, repealing the previous CMW bylaw in the process.

The new bylaw ensures a seat on the CMW Executive Committee for a representative from each operational pole providing midwifery services. It also creates a non-voting seat on the CMW Executive Committee for a Cree midwife trainee (Chiskutimwaakan) representative.



Council of Midwives: Annual Report

The Council of Midwives (CMW) deposited its 2024-2025 Annual Report. The report outlined the activities of the CMW's Executive Committee as well as the other committees of the Council. It also presents the data collected by the CMV related to midwifery services in Eeyou Istchee and documents the range of collaborative activities undertaken by the CMV with other groups both within the CBHSSJB and external to the organizations.





Appointment of Interim AED – Miyupimaatisiiun

The Board appointed Holly Danyluk as interim Assistant Executive Director – Miyupimaatisiiun, effective September 20 until a new AED is appointed.

The AED – Miyupimaatisiiun position will be vacant as the current AED, Christina Biron, will be serving as interim Executive Director as of September 20. Ms. Biron will work closely with Ms. Danyluk to ensure her successful integration and orientation into this position.

Nancy Shecapio-Blacksmith will be the Interim Proximity Director for Waskaganish Pole, replacing Holly Danyluk.
